Site regulations require dogs to be on-lead or crated when not being tested. **Please clean up after your pet and use designed trash receptacles for disposal.**

## All-Breed Draft Test

---

*Saturday and Sunday following conclusion of NCA Draft Test*

This test is open to any purebred dog (including Newfoundlands) as well as mixed breeds. The test will follow the NCA Draft Test Regulations and be judged by the same judges. However, this is not an NCA test and will not automatically result in a title for passing dogs. Entrants must check with their own breed clubs to determine if this test will meet the draft test requirements for those clubs. Entrants must bring appropriate paperwork for the judges to sign. The judges will not be responsible for submitting required paperwork to individual breed clubs. Trophies will be offered for dogs who pass this test.

# About the Site

## Salvation Army's Three Trails Camp and Retreat Center

This was our new site in 2011 and hopefully will be for many years to come. The hilly, wooded site seems to be very secluded while it is really less than two miles from the major business strip of Independence, MO, a city of over 100,000 people and a suburb of Kansas City.

The camp has both wooded and open areas, as well as multiple trails and bridges. The Basic Control area will be set up in a completely enclosed tennis court. Natural and man-made obstacles that will be worked into the maneuvering course. Both the maneuvering course and the freight haul will traverse hilly areas. Surfaces include asphalt, gravel, natural rock, trail surfaces, and grassy areas. The narrowest area is 46". Natural distractions include wildlife, other groups using the area and spectators.

Buildings at the camp include an administration office, dining hall and a variety of lodging accommodations (see the website). Unfortunately, dogs aren't allowed in the buildings. We have rented a large room in the dining hall which we will use for check-in and lunch. The room will be available all day for breaks from the weather if necessary. The room opens to a large covered deck where we can crate the dogs, giving them protection from either hot or wet weather. Dollies will be available for moving crates. Exhibitors are welcome to bring their pop-up tents, but they are probably unnecessary. All dogs must be on leash or crated except when being tested.

# Directions to the Site

**From the West East:** Take I-70 to the Lee's Summit Road exit (Exit 14) in Independence, MO. Go south and turn right (west) on 40 Highway. The entrance to the camp will be on your right.

**From the South and Southwest:** Take I-35 to I-435 east to I-470 east (or take 71 Hwy to I-470 east). Exit at US 40 Hwy and turn left (west); after the light at Lee's Summit Road, the camp will be on your right.

**From the North:** Take I-29 or I-35 south to I-435 East (toward St. Louis); Exit on I-70 East (toward St. Louis); Take I-70 to the Lee's Summit Road exit (Exit 14) in Independence, MO. Go south (right) and turn right on 40 Highway. The entrance to the camp will be on your right.



# Motel and Camping

---

We've selected the popular Comfort Inn & Suites of Lee's Summit, MO (3701 NE Ralph Powell Road/816.554.6688) as our motel for the Draft Test. It is about 10 minutes from the test site and 10 minutes from our Saturday night dinner restaurant. *This is a nice hotel.* So let's be sure to leave a good impression on them. **Please crate your dog when left unattended in your room and clean up after exercising your dog.** The hotel will report any room damage to the draft test committee. We will report offending exhibitors to the NCA.

## **DIRECTIONS TO COMFORT INN:**

From I-470, take Exit #12 Woods Chapel Road; go west past Price Chopper and turn left on Ralph Powell Road.

## **DIRECTIONS FROM COMFORT INN TO TEST SITE:**

Go north on Ralph Powell Rd and turn right on Woods Chapel Rd. Go north on I-470 to the US 40 Hwy exit; Exit and turn left on US 40; continue west; the camp will be on your right after you pass the traffic lights at Lee's Summit Road.

## **DIRECTIONS FROM TEST SITE TO COMFORT INN:**

Exit the camp turning left on US 40 Hwy. Turn right on the ramp to I-470 south; exit at Woods Chapel Road (exit 12) and turn right; go past Price Chopper and turn left on Ralph Powell Road.

## **DIRECTIONS FROM COMFORT INN TO HICKORY PIT BBQ**

Go north on Ralph Powell Rd and turn right on Woods Chapel Rd. Go south on I-470; stay in the left lane to continue south on MO 291 Hwy; continue through Lee's Summit and turn left on Blue Parkway (the outer road just before the 350/50 Hwy exits. Watch for the Hickory Pit on your left.

## NCA Aggression Policy \_\_\_\_\_

The NCA Board has adopted the official AKC policy with regards to dog aggression for use at NCA working events, such as Water and Draft tests. That policy is as follows: "Any dog, that in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated." It is very important that each handler keep watch over his or her own dog (s), to avoid any possible confrontation that might result in a Test Committee hearing on the matter, etc.
